In November, the McClave School Board and Administration asked our school community for their input on facility planning considerations with the use of a survey and received 99 responses. We would like to thank all of those that took the time to complete the survey and provide additional comments. We value your feedback and will continue to seek it throughout this process. A summary of the survey results can be found on the following page.

The School board and Administration plan to continue discussions concerning school facilities with the goal of developing a long-term facility master plan. This process is expected to take some time as we consider our options and we don't anticipate any major renovations or construction to begin until extensive planning has occurred. We will continue to explore options that will lessen costs, including researching BEST Grant funding and timelines. We also plan to solicit expertise from companies that specialize in school facility planning and renovation/construction to better understand our options. Our school is the anchor of our community and we hope to lay the groundwork to continue that tradition for generations to come.

## Questions:

- 1. Good facilities are an important part of a high-quality education for McClave students.
- 2. I support the development of a long-term facility master plan for McClave School District to explore and analyze options.
- 3. I would attend a community meeting to discuss various options and ideas.
- 4. Accurate cost projections and/or quotes will be important in the decision-making process.
- 5. I encourage the McClave School District to consider a BEST Grant application to request state funds, which would pay for part of our facility improvement expense.
- 6. I would support a major renovation/updating or new construction if it can be down without a tax increase.
- 7. I would support a major renovation/updating or new construction with a property tax increase if it is required for the McClave School District to receive cost sharing funds from the state.
- 8. In general, I tend to support the idea of renovation/updating.
- 9. In general, I tend to support the idea of new construction.
- 10. I believe a complete K-12 replacement with new construction should be an option under consideration.
