QUALIFICATIONS

The bus driver must:

- 1. possess a valid school bus driver's license with all of the endorsements required by the Colorado Department of Education.
- 2. be at least 21 years of age.
- 3. pass the Department of Transportation physical examination and keep a current DOT physical on file.
- 4. satisfactorily complete the required first aid course within 90 days of employment and keep current certification on file.
- 5. maintain a satisfactory driving record as established by CDE and the DOT.
- 6. comply with random District drug and alcohol testing.
- 7. complete a minimum of six hours of annual in-service training.

The Bus Driver reports to the Superintendent of Schools. The driver's overriding goal should be the safe and efficient transportation of students of the McClave School District Re-2.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Driving

The school bus driver must:

- 1. operate the bus in a responsible and professional manner in accordance with all laws over any assigned route while keeping with the assigned schedule.
- 2. greet all students in a pleasant manner with a positive attitude.
- 3. maintain positive student discipline in accordance with established policies and regulations.
- 4. utilize defensive driving techniques.
- 5. keep a daily mileage log and also keep up route information sheets and student manifests.

Safety

The school bus driver must:

- 1. perform all pre and post trip inspections as required by law and enter them in the assigned log book.
- 2. adhere to posted speed limits making adjustments for roads, weather and traffic conditions.
- 3. transport only authorized students.
- 4. discharge students only at authorized stops.
- 5. conduct emergency evacuation drills at least twice a year (once per semester)
- 6. maintain the bus in clean condition.
- 7. check and maintain fluid levels of the vehicle, including fuel, oil, and coolant.

Communications

The school bus driver must:

- 1. report in writing immediately, all defects in equipment, vandalism, or damages.
- 2. report all accidents, incidents or possible hazards to the superintendent.
- 3. use the cell phone to immediately notify the school in cases of break-downs or delays.
- 4. report all personal traffic violations to the superintendent.
- 5. submit all required records and reports.
- 6. promote and follow all Board of Education policies, procedures, and any other rules established by the school administration.
- 7. assist in route development.
- 8. dress appropriately for all work assignments and comply with expectations as stated in school district policy.

Discipline

The school bus driver must:

- 1. maintain proper student control on the bus at all times.
- 2. notify the principal or designee immediately of problems related to student discipline which interferes with the safe transportation of students.
- 3. enforce all school policies on drug or tobacco use on the school bus.
